General Eligibility/Requirements Include:

- Citizen or national of BiH, or permanent resident qualified to hold a valid BiH passport
- Completed undergraduate education and have a bachelor's degree or equivalent
- Enrolled in good standing in an accredited master's or doctoral program in the proposed field of study
- Not scheduled to complete graduate studies at home institution before the start of or during the program
- Cleared by a physician to participate in the program (finalists only)
- English language proficiency (finalists must take the TOEFL exam)
- Committed to returning to BiH for a minimum of two years.

Not Eligible:

- Candidates with dual U.S. citizenship or U.S. permanent resident status
- Candidates who have attended undergraduate or graduate school in the United States for one academic year or more during the seven years prior to date of application
- Candidates who have resided in the United States for five or more consecutive years (nine months or more during a calendar year) in the six-year period preceding the date of application
- Candidates in the medical field, seeking to participate in activities for which a license to practice medicine or nursing is required.

Application Guidelines:

The **<u>online</u>** application must include the following supporting documents:

- Detailed research objectives
- Detailed personal statement
- Detailed curriculum vitae or resume
- Three letters of recommendation
- Copies of all post-secondary and university degrees and academic transcripts (finalists

must provide official records with certified English translation)

- Employer's letter of support, if applicable
- Report on Proficiency in English form
- Foreign Student Academic Records form
- Copy of BiH passport biographical page
- Signature form.
