The Fulbright Foreign Student Program Visiting Student Researcher category provides grants (financial support) to conduct non-degree, full-time research at the graduate level from a minimum of four months to a maximum of nine months at U.S. institutions of higher education.

Participants advance their academic work, establish professional contacts in their fields of study, gain international experience and personal enrichment, and help promote mutual understanding between the United States and Bosnia and Herzegovina.
